

<u>Gen Verde</u> is **internationally recognized** for creating sacred and liturgical music. Gen Verde com-positions are regularly played and sung in places of worship around the world.

To respond to a growing number of requests from parish and diocesan groups as well as ecumen-ical bodies, **Gen Verde has developed a formation program focused on the role of music within liturgy, in the service and aid of prayer**. The activity culminates in a final celebratory liturgy.

The project is specifically addressed **to choir members and musicians** who want to deepen the role of singing and music in the liturgy.



Gen Verde offers three types of Choral

**Workshops** which vary in length and difficulty. Organizers can choose the most suitable format based on the level of participants and the time available for the project.

Each choral workshop includes separate guided rehearsal sessions for each vocal section and for instrumentalists and rehearsals with the entire group, during which participants have the oppor-tunity to deepen the various aspects of the celebration.



The experience ends with a vigil, or Mass, animated by the choristers together with Gen Verde.

A church or other appropriate location where the final rehearsal and the concluding Mass will take place. Before the final rehearsal, a suitable position for the choir and instruments must be prepared.
